

Good afternoon --

I wanted to touch base with you all and thank you for assisting us with the marketing of the Bureau of Justice Assistance Advanced Methamphetamine Investigative Training to be held in Columbia, South Carolina on March 22, 2012. The response for the training has really been phenomenal. In a little over a week, we have exceeded the capacity of the facility. To accommodate the overage, we have contacted the United States Attorney's Office, District of South Carolina and they have secured a second date at the Bill Rogers Community Connections Center, South Carolina Department of Juvenile Justice on March 21, 2011. The facility can accommodate another 100 people. However, if all the folks yet to be confirmed for training accept confirmation for March 21, we should have about another 40 seats available.

Tonya Baker and I will be contacting those individuals on the March 22nd waitlist for the training and offer them the opportunity to attend the training on March 21st.

We will not do another flyer for the training but we will post it to our website showing that the March 22 class is full and allow registration for March 21. Registration for March 21 is available on the Web.
